



Camper Medication Form

1. Please fill out and send this form to camp with your child if they need to take medication while attending. All medications, **including over the counter**, must be kept in the Health Center and administered by the Camp Nurse.
2. Medication must be in the original prescription container with the correctly prescribed dosage and child's name. **Prescribed meds with a name other than the child's name will NOT be given.**
3. Place medication in a Ziploc bag with this completed form. Be prepared to give Ziploc to the adult responsible for bringing your child to camp; they will turn this in to the camp nurse at check-in.
4. Circle Six Camp does have a well-stocked Health Center. Many of the basic over-the-counter medications your child may need should be available and stocked (i.e.: Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Band-Aids, Benadryl, cough medicine, etc.). You do not need to send these types of medication with your child. However, specialty items (i.e.: Zyrtec, Allegra, etc.) can be sent to camp if needed. Should your child require over the counter medication, please be sure to write your child's name on the container or box and place it in the Ziploc bag.
5. If your child is required to keep a rescue inhaler or epi-pen with them, designate this on the form below. Please stress to him/her the importance of keeping these items with him/her **AT ALL TIMES!**
6. If you choose to use essential oils while at home you may send them to camp with your child. These do not need to be kept in the Health Center and will not be administered by the Camp Nurse. However, your child may keep these with them or turn them in to their church group leader. Circle Six is not responsible for damaged/lost oils while at camp.
7. Circle Six Camp does have a designated Camp Nurse on site and available 24/7 during summer camps. Please know that we are here for your child and will do everything we can to ensure that they are well taken care of during their session of camp! However, we do not have the capability to keep up with hundreds of campers individually. **Talk to your child (and their church group leader) about taking responsibility to come by when it is time for them to take their medication.** This saves a lot of time and trouble while they are here, and ensures that they are as healthy and safe as possible!
